SEISMIC ACTIVITY - SUMATRA

The Directors of Coziron Resources Ltd ("Coziron") would like to inform the public and shareholders alike, that exploration activities undertaken by the Company have not in any way been affected by recent seismic activity in Western Sumatra.

Two earthquakes, measuring in order of magnitude 6.3 and 6.1 respectively (and according to seismologists at the US Geological Survey), were centered approximately 50 kilometers north east of Padang city; in the Regency of Solok. The earthquakes struck the Island Tuesday morning and effects of the activity were felt as far as Malaysia and Singapore.

The Company would like to extend their deepest sympathy to families that have either been displaced, or whom have suffered loss during the event.

Coziron will continue to monitor activity in the region.
