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DEFENCE ESTATE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION SERVICES CONTRACT EXTENSION

Downer EDI Limited (Downer) today announced it had received an extension on its Estate Maintenance and Operation Services (EMOS) contract with the Australian Department of Defence.

The 12-month extension will commence in August 2024 and run through to 31 July 2025, generating revenue to Downer of approximately \$400 million.
