dorsaVi secures London Underground and VINCI Construction as its first UK occupational health and safety customers

Melbourne, Australia and London, UK: Medical device company dorsaVi Ltd (ASX: DVL) today announced the signing of its first two UK-based occupational health and safety (OHS) customers: London Underground and VINCI Construction UK Ltd. The agreements with the two industry leaders represent a major milestone for the Australian company who formally introduced its innovative OHS technology, ViSafe™, into the UK market in March this year.

dorsaVi's ViSafe™ workplace solutions utilises revolutionary wearable sensors to objectively measure human movement and turn it into actionable data. Together with safety conscious companies, dorsaVi finds solutions to reduce risk and associated costs.

The London Underground carried more than a billion passengers last year and is the oldest rapid transit system in the world. dorsaVi's ViSafe™ workplace solutions will provide Stations and Distribution Services, a division of TfL's London Underground with objective measurement and evidence based solutions to design ergonomically improved vehicles for current and future drivers.

VINCI employs 68,000 employees in 100 countries and VINCI is its UK branch that encompasses three divisions. VINCI will use ViSafe workplace solutions to objectively assess and document the impact of novel work practices and provide evidence of risk reduction among employees.

"The transportation and construction sectors are ideally suited to ViSafe" said Zoe Whyatt, dorsaVi Europe COO. "With the intensive manual handling and repetitive movements involved, these workers too commonly experience back and shoulder problems. ViSafe can change this pattern. By capturing real-time and real-world data, ViSafe consultants collaborate with companies to provide solutions to reduce workplace injuries and the corresponding costs."
