### **dorsaVi signs NFL teams to use ViPerform**

**Melbourne, Australia** – Medical device company dorsaVi Ltd (ASX: DVL) has signed two leading National Football League (NFL) teams for the use of its ViPerform technology. The New Orleans Saints and Cleveland Browns are the latest professional sports teams to adopt the technology.

dorsaVi is pleased to see the growing awareness of its products resulting from the adoption by high profile elite sports clubs and leading health professionals in the US and around the world. These two NFL teams have been incorporating the technology in team training protocols during the off-season, and all will now utilise the sensor technology during the 2015-16 season to assess and monitor players and guide recovery of their athletes.

The NFL is multi-billion dollar enterprise and is considered the highest grossing sports league in the world. While the NFL consists of just 32 teams, there are an additional 400 College teams that closely monitor technology adoption at the elite levels. There are also over 2700 Sports medicine physicians in the US who look to elite sporting teams to validate emerging technology before adopting it into their own practice. In addition to the latest contracts in the NFL, dorsaVi has also signed agreements with the Toronto FC in the MLS, and the newly crowned NBA champion, Golden State Warriors. When professional sports teams trust ViPerform data to assess their multi-million dollar athletes, doctors take notice.

“At any company, the employees are the greatest assets and need protection,” said dorsaVi US President John Kowalczyk. “At the NFL, the stakes are even higher with multi-million dollar athletes. We’re proud that these elite sports clubs are choosing to use dorsaVi sensor technology to assess risk of injury, guide training programs, and help determine when it’s safe for an injured athlete to return to play.”

ViPerform consists of small wireless sensors that are placed on the body and provide immediate analysis of movement and muscle activity by recording and sending objective data to a PC, tablet or small recording device for review.

ViPerform is being used by AFL and NRL clubs in Australia, clubs in the Barclays Premier League, Australian and Victorian Institutes of Sport, Cricket Australia and various Olympic teams and athletes internationally.
- **OHS:** We combine innovation, measurement and quality to reduce workplace incidents, costs, meet compliance and improve brand reputation. ViSafe enables employers to assess risk of injury for employees as well as test the effectiveness of proposed changes to workplace design, equipment or methods based on objective evidence.
