Large workforce employer turning to dorsaVi to improve workplace safety and culture

Melbourne, Australia - Wearable sensor medical device company dorsaVi Ltd (ASX: DVL) has today announced that Sodexo, one of the world's largest services and labour hire companies, has entered a 12 month contract to undertake assessments of their employees working in remote areas of Australia. This is the third and most significant project that dorsaVi has undertaken with Sodexo, a world leader in quality of life services.

The French company employs more than 420,000 employees globally with 4000 based in Australia. Sodexo delivers a unique array of integrated services lines including: facilities management, food services, concierge services, security, asset maintenance and hospitality services, operating in a range of sectors including mining, oil and gas, corporate, education, and aged care.

Sodexo will lease dorsaVi's ViSafe technology to undertake its own testing and assessments of workers involved in manual handling activities and tasks in remote sites in Australia. dorsaVi will be responsible for the analysis of data, producing insights and action points to allow Sodexo to make informed decisions.

Sodexo and dorsaVi are discussing the rollout of the ViSafe program across its network in Australia and overseas, which will clearly position Sodexo as an innovator in workplace safety and culture globally, and establish best practice in reducing workplace injury.

Whilst dorsaVi is unable to disclose the specific contractual terms of the agreement, the company can confirm this is the first contract where ViSafe and dorsaVi will be utilised to provide ongoing maintenance and support to a large multi-site organisation over a 12 month period.

Large workforces are increasingly turning to dorsaVi's workplace solutions. dorsaVi now names some of the largest workforces in Australia, the US and UK as its clients including Caterpillar, Sodexo, BP, Vinci, Transport for London and Crown.

Mark Heaysman, Group OHS and Compliance Business Manager, said: "This is the third project we've done with Sodexo, which has the potential to expand to other sites in Australia and overseas. I see Sodexo is taking a strong leadership position in tackling workplace safety and applying state of the art technology to not only protect its workers from injury but improve the day-to-day work environment."

"Our technology offering and workplace solutions are resonating with these large employers because we offer objective, reliable and cost effective tools to inform decisions. Large workforces, particularly those with high manual handling activities, are seeking solutions to reduce workplace injury."

dorsaVi (ASX: DVL) is an ASX company focused on developing innovative motion analysis device technologies for use in elite sports, occupational health and safety, and clinical applications. dorsaVi believes its wearable sensor technology enables – for the first time – many aspects of detailed human movement and position to be accurately captured, quantified and assessed outside a biomechanics lab, in both real-time and real situations for up to 24 hours.

Our technology has applications across three sectors:

- **OH&S:** We combine innovation, measurement and quality to reduce workplace incidents, costs, meet compliance and improve brand reputation. ViSafe enables employers to assess risk of injury for employees as well as test the effectiveness of proposed changes to workplace design, equipment or methods based on objective evidence. ViSafe has been used by major corporations including Coles, Woolworths, Toll, Toyota, Orora (formerly Amcor), Crown and BHP Billiton. Australian Workplace Compliance delivers risk mitigation through compliance to OHS, Quality Management Systems, Company Policy and Process.
- **Clinical:** ViMove is transforming the management of patients by providing objective assessment, monitoring outside the clinic and immediate biofeedback. ViMove is currently used by medical and physiotherapy practices in Australia and the United Kingdom and is now available in the United States following FDA 510(k) clearance.
- **Elite Sports:** ViPerform is allowing coaches and medical teams managing elite athletes and teams to screen athletes and provide objective evidence for decisions on return to play, measure biomechanics and provide immediate biofeedback out on the field, tailor and track training programs and optimise technique and peak performance. ViPerform is being used by AFL and NRL clubs in Australia, clubs in the Barclays Premier League, Australian and Victorian Institutes of Sport, various Olympic teams and athletes internationally, and Cricket Australia.
