EGL WINS KEY ORDER IN VICTORIA

The Environmental Group Limited (EGL) has been awarded a contract by Leighton Contractors Pty Ltd to carry out the design, manufacture, supply and commissioning of the propylene oxide vapour emission scrubbing system for the Marstel Coode Island Terminal Project.

Marstel Terminals are undertaking the development of a new facility on Melbourne's Coode Island to receive shiploads of propylene oxide, benzene, styrene and other chemicals, and to store and distribute them to various industrial end users. Leighton Contractors have been awarded the construction contract by Marstel.

The propylene oxide scrubbing system uses technology supplied by Ceilcote Air Pollution Control (Cleveland, USA), one of EGL's major technology suppliers. The sensitive nature of the Coode Island site requires a well designed, well constructed system appropriate to the site. EGL's extensive prior experience in supplying systems to terminal facilities throughout the world will be instrumental in satisfying the project requirements.

This is the sixth major scrubbing system awarded by Leighton Contractors and their affiliates over the last 12 months to EGL for projects in Western Australia, Queensland and now Victoria. This is recognition of EGL's position as the leading supplier of advanced technology air emissions scrubbing systems in Australia, and of the professional approach and high quality management systems that EGL adopts in carrying out its business.
