EGL WINS MAJOR ORDER FOR MURRIN MURRIN

The Environmental Group Limited (EGL) has been awarded another contract to supply an acid demister at the Murrin Murrin nickel-cobalt plant in Western Australia. The contract is valued at approximately \$850,000.

It is the second such system ordered by the Murrin Murrin joint venture¹ following on from the successful design, supply and commissioning of a similar system last year which proved highly successful in reducing corrosion and maintenance downtime and increasing production.

The process employed by EGL for this application is one of a number of technologies ideally suited to the mining, mineral processing and oil and gas industries currently available from EGL.

EGL continues to be well placed to provide proven innovative environmental solutions to its mineral processing and oil and gas clients in an area which remains one of the company's most successful and competitive fields of operation.

The contract has been fast-tracked and is due for completion by March 2007.

It is a joint venture between Murrin Murrin Holdings Pty Ltd, a wholly owned subsidiary of Minara Resources Limited, and Glenmurrin Pty Ltd, a wholly owned subsidiary of Glencore International AG.
