Talent Lab is available as an on-premise or hosted solution. Pricing starts at US\$5,000 per month for organisations with a population fewer than 10,000. Clients typically sign a 12-month subscription agreement with full payment received in advance.

Estrella proposes to acquire Data Labs following completion of a number of conditions precedent including mutual due diligence, shareholder approval and re-compliance with the ASX listing rules.
