RE: SUCCESSFUL TESTING OUTCOME FOR PRODUCTION, HOLLYWOOD PROSPECT, LAKE LONG, LOUISIANA, USA

Since the last report of Thursday 26 July 2007 on the SL328 # 9 well on the Hollywood Prospect, Lake Long, Louisiana, completion operations on the 24 feet of net pay in the Middle Hollywood Sands continued, leading to perforation of the pay, clean up and flow testing.

The pay flow on restricted testing averaged 2,364,000 scf/d with 55 boc with no water at 4,584# flowing pressure on 10/64" choke. Reservoir analysis suggest the well should easily produce at 4,000,000 scf/d with +/- 100 boc. The well has been shut in so that a small permanent production platform can be built around the well head, and well equipment and flow lines to the Operator's nearby gas processing plant can be installed. ***Production with sales to market should commence in late August at the planned 4,000,000 scf/d with associated condensate.***

The Upper Hollywood Sands in the well (where 13 feet of additional net pay has been logged) will be produced at a later date. Participants' interests on completion of the well are;
