Bulago and Muller Range Warden's Court Hearing Set

Frontier Resources Limited (**Frontier** or the **Company**) is pleased to announce that the Warden's Court Hearing for EL1595 Bulago and EL2356 Muller Range in the Southern Highlands Province, PNG (see Figures below), has been set down for September 26th. The Warden's Court Hearing to consult landowners is part of the normal tenement renewal process prior to recommendation for renewal by the Mining Advisory Council to the Mining Minister.

Earlier in the year, the Warden's Court Hearings and proposed Muller Range and Bulago exploration programs were deferred following logistical and security issues in the Southern Highlands caused by the 7.5 magnitude earthquake. These programs are planned to re-commence as soon as practicable.

A meeting was recently held in PNG with the MRA technical team to summarise Frontier's exploration activities and recent corporate changes.

At Bulago, assaying occurred during the year and the Company has met its financial commitments for the tenement. The MRA has granted a variation to exclude fieldwork trenching for the year.

To date, a total of 5247.75 metres in 37 drill holes have been completed on the tenement. The most recent include:

- Four diamond holes (CLD: 161.3m total of HQ) completed at the Swit Kai Central Lower Zone in October 2016.
- Five diamond holes (EZL: 152.7m total of HQ) completed at East Creek in October 2016.
- Three diamond holes (FDH: 93.6m total of HQ) completed at Swit Kai Central Lower Zone in March 2017.
- Two diamond holes (GCZ: 392.1m total) completed in Bulago Valley in May 2017.

At Muller Range, an Aster satellite imagery study over the three tenement blocks delineated 37 Aster targets that were recommended for future geochemical sampling and geological mapping.
