PORTIA GOLD MINE CONTINUES STEADY PROGRESS

HIGHLIGHTS

- **549,000 m³ of material moved during the month of July – 37% increase compared to prior month.**
- **Third operating crew added allowing both mining fleets to be operated 7 days a week.**

Havilah Resources Limited (“Havilah” or “Company”) is pleased to report that operations at the Portia gold mine near Broken Hill continued to progress according to plan during the month of July.

Notable developments during July included:

1. Movement of 549,000 m³ of overburden material.
2. Total overburden material moved since start-up – 1.3 million m³ (Remaining overburden - 5.7 million m³).
3. Addition of a third operating crew by Consolidated Mining & Civil Pty Ltd (CMC), meaning that both mining fleets, comprising two Hitachi EX2500 250 tonne excavators and ten 100 tonne dump trucks, are now operating 12 hours a day and seven days a week.
4. Completion of all site infrastructure.

Commenting on progress, Havilah's Managing Director, Dr Chris Giles, said "The third operating crew makes full use of the two fleets of mining equipment, operating on day shifts only, and we expect further increases in monthly overburden movements over the next few months.

"Havilah continues to focus on assembling all components for the Portia gold processing plant, and has appointed a project manager to oversee the task, with the view to commissioning the processing plant on site early in 2016."
