Provident class action – settlement update

IOOF Holdings Ltd (ASX:IFL, OTC:IOOFY) (IOOF) announced today, in accordance with its continuous disclosure obligations, that IOOF and IOOF's wholly-owned subsidiary, Australian Executor Trustees Limited (AET), have agreed conditional settlements in relation to the remaining two cross-claims noted in the announcement of 7 August 2018 in the proceedings relating to Provident Capital Limited (the Provident Proceedings).

As announced on 7 August, the amount AET has agreed to pay to the plaintiffs and group members in the Provident Proceedings is \$44.25 million. Earlier today, these settlements were approved by the Court which also had the effect of causing the settlement of the remaining two cross-claims to become unconditional settlements.

As a result of the agreed settlements with PwC, HLB Mann Judd, IOOF's insurers and insurance broker in respect of the cross-claims brought by AET against those parties as part of the Provident Proceedings, IOOF's net contribution to the settlement arising from the Provident Proceedings is approximately \$8m.

Subject to any appeal of the Court's decision to approve AET's settlements with the plaintiffs and group members, these settlements resolve all aspects of the Provident Proceedings.
