APPOINTMENT OF CORPORATE ADVISORS

Dear Sirs

The Board is pleased to announce the appointment of Delta Securities (Delta) as corporate advisors to the Imdex Limited Group (Imdex).

Delta is a Perth based provider of securities trading, corporate consulting and portfolio management services.

The Board has engaged Delta to assist Imdex in its corporate development as the company seeks to expand and develop into a significant global drilling products and services provider. Delta will assist the company in developing corporate strategies, supplying market research, providing advice on investor relations and advising on capital management strategies.

As part of the fees that Delta will receive for acting as corporate advisors, the Board has sought to provide Delta with a performance incentive through the issue of 2,000,000, 3 year options exercisable at 20 cents on the condition that Imdex shares trade at 30 cents for 5 consecutive trading days and 1,000,000, 3 year options exercisable at 35 cents.

In addition, the Board has also issued 100,000, 20 cent options to a consultant of the company in recognition of his past and future contribution to the Group.
