Valleyarm expects to generate an additional US\$1.5 million over the next 12 months through its distribution of this content to digital music services providers, telecommunications carriers and online stores such as iTunes, Nokia Ovi, China Mobile, Amazon and Telstra Bigpond.

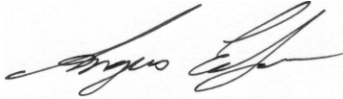
