

Australia's Largest Assessment Delivered on Janison, 100% Online for Second Year

Janison Education Group Limited (**ASX:JAN**) ("**Janison**" or the "**Company**"), is pleased to announce it has successfully completed the online assessment phase of NAPLAN 2023 (the "National Assessment Program – Literacy & Numeracy"). For the second year running the assessment was delivered fully online across all 9,300 participating schools – the culmination of seven years of product development in partnership with Education Services Australia and Microsoft leveraging hyperscale Azure cloud technology.

In the second week of March 2023, Janison's assessment platform delivered 4.4 million tests (over 1 million in a single day) for almost 1.3 million students. At its peak, more than 0.3 million students simultaneously sat the exam on Janison's platform – seamlessly and without issue.

CEO of Education Services Australia ("ESA"), Andrew Smith, said of the event: *"ESA are proud of the role Janison and ESA have played in delivering a successful NAPLAN event to students across Australia. The success of the event is a testament to the expertise, preparation and collaboration of all involved."*

Janison's assessment software powered NAPLAN Online for the sixth year, across all states and territories in school years three, five, seven and nine. Test statistics this year set another new record for the number of tests delivered on Janison Insights in a single week – believed to be larger than any other online school assessment globally. In doing so, Janison reaffirmed its market-leading position of seamlessly delivering the highest level of security, reliability, and scalable infrastructure for online exams in an equitable and accessible manner for all students.

Together with ACARA (Australian Curriculum, Assessment and Reporting Authority), several other strategic partners support the implementation of the NAPLAN program each year. These partners include state and territory education departments, Education Services Australia (ESA), and technology providers including Janison as the assessment platform provider and Microsoft Azure for its cloud hosting services.

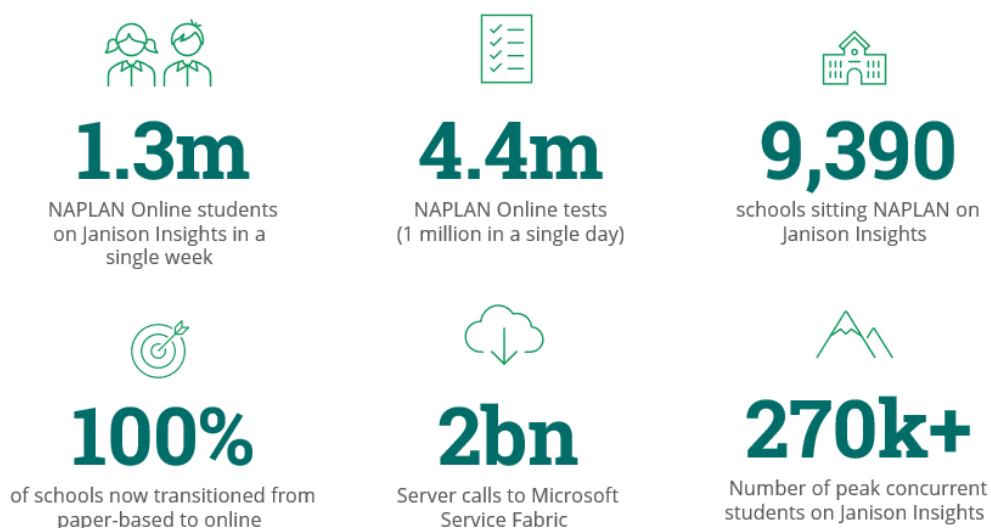
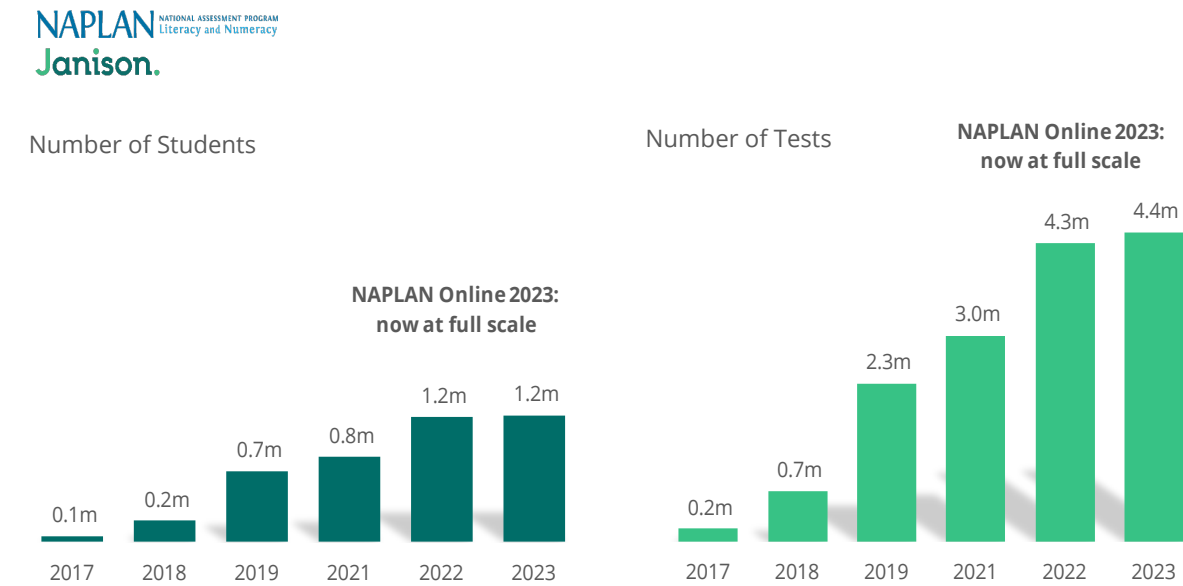


Fig 2. NAPLAN Online digital transition:
