

CVCheck appointed as exclusive provider of Children's Workers Safety Checks for New Zealand Ministries

- **System is also available for other organisations or persons who require these checks under the legislation**

Leading online screening and verification company, CVCheck Ltd (ASX: CV1) ("CVCheck") is pleased to announce that it has been selected to provide Children's Worker Safety Checks for specified groups of children's workers from the New Zealand Ministries of Health, Education, and Social Development.

The CVCheck service will also be widely available to meet the demand of other organisations or individual workers who need to comply with New Zealand's Vulnerable Children Act 2014 (the Act).

Under the Act, any individual working with children in an organisation that receives state funding must be adequately safety checked. To meet this need, CVCheck has been appointed as the exclusive provider of the Cross Agency Independent Safety Checking Service to ensure that all self-employed children's workers or sole practitioners who receive state funding are screened in accordance with the safety checking requirements under the Act.

As part of the service, CVCheck will provide applicants with a report regarding the outcome of their check, keep a record of the check on the Company's database and alert customers as to when they need to be re-checked. Under the Act, children's workers are required to have safety checks completed every three years.

The specific groups of children's workers that are now required to use the CVCheck service include:

- General Practitioners owner operators;
- Locum doctors and nurses;
- Dentists contracted under the Combined Dental Agreement;
- Lead maternity carers and midwives funded under section 88 Primary Maternity Services Notice;
- Early childhood owner operators;
- Ministry of Social Development sole contractors whose work involves engagement with children (such as holiday program workers).

CVCheck acting CEO Rod Sherwood commented: "The Company is very encouraged by the smooth implementation and delivery of this service to satisfy the contract secured earlier this year with the New Zealand Ministry of Health. It serves as a major endorsement of the Company's service offering and the flexibility of our technology platform. The partnership underpins CVCheck's entry into New Zealand.
