PROJECT UPDATE

Further to the Company's release of the 12th August 2005 and the 2005 Annual Report, the work commissioned to evaluate alternative means of removing calcium from the leaching circuit has now been received.

The utilisation of CO₂ from flue gas has been shown to remove a significant proportion of calcium from the leach liquor. However, the estimated reduction in operating cost, although not insignificant, leaves the projects economics in an area considered by the Board to be marginal. Additional optimisation work may be undertaken to resolve this operating cost issue.

The Board has determined that it requires time to consider these results in more detail and develop a strategy for the Company in relation to the Latrobe Magnesium Project.

The Board has decided to raise \$100,000 to provide it with working capital.
