Section 708A(5)(e) Notice

Magnetite Mines Limited (ASX:MGT) (“Company”) advises that, following shareholder approval obtained at the Extraordinary General Meeting held on 5 March 2025, it has issued in aggregate 319,655 fully paid ordinary shares to directors Mr. Paul White (or his associates) and Mr. Simon Wandke in lieu of a portion of their director remuneration for the period 1 July 2025 to 30 September 2025, as per the Appendix 2A lodged today.

As part of the Company’s initiative to reduce cash expenditures, Mr. White and Mr. Wandke agreed to forgo a portion of their director’s fees in cash. Instead, they received a grant of Director Shares under the Company’s Employee Incentive Plan, with the share allocation equivalent in value to the amount of fees they had elected to forgo for the period, divided by the Company’s average daily VWAP of \$0.1017 on ASX over that period, subject to a minimum average daily VWAP of \$0.08.

The Company hereby notifies the ASX under section 708A(5)(e) of the Corporations Act (the “**Act**”) that:

1. the Company issued the shares without disclosure to Mr White (or his associates) and Mr Wandke under Part 6D.2 of the Act;
2. as at the date of this notice the Company has complied with the provisions of Chapter 2M of the Act as they apply to the Company, and section 674 and section 674A of the Act; and
3. as at the date of this notice there is no excluded information of the type referred to in sections 708A(7) and 708A(8) of the Act that is required to be set out in this notice under section 708A(6)(e) of the Act.

Magnetite Mines Ltd is an ASX-listed iron ore company focused on the development of magnetite iron ore resources in the highly-prospective Braemar iron region of South Australia.
