MAJOR VTEM SURVEY UNDERWAY AT YARMANY

HIGHLIGHTS:

- Airborne Electromagnetic (AEM) survey utilising the UTS Geophysics VTEMTM Max system commences at the Yarmany Project
- The 1,143 line kilometre survey will cover the entire 50km strike extent of the Yarmany tenements, targeting massive nickel sulphide mineralisation along the Ida Fault
- Survey results will support ongoing regional interpretation and target generation for komatiite-hosted nickel sulphides
- First EM survey ever conducted over the Yarmany project area

Metal Hawk Limited (**ASX: MHK**, “Metal Hawk”, “the Company”) is pleased to announce the commencement of a major geophysical electromagnetic survey across the Company’s Yarmany Project, north-west of Coolgardie in Western Australia.

In July 2023 Metal Hawk signed an option to acquire the Yarmany Project, which covers 282km² along the Ida Fault, a major regional structure and crustal boundary between the Kalgoorlie and Youanmi Terranes, from gold development company Horizon Minerals Limited (ASX: HRZ).

Metal Hawk’s Managing Director Will Belbin commented: *“This is a very exciting time for Metal Hawk as this is the very first EM survey carried out on the Yarmany project. We look forward to seeing the results from this survey as we are confident it will generate quality nickel sulphide drill targets.”*

VTEM Max Survey

UTS Geophysics Pty Ltd (Geotech) has commenced the survey utilising its helicopter-borne Versatile Time-Domain Electromagnetic (VTEMTM Max) geophysical system. This method of electromagnetic surveying is excellent for location of discrete conductive anomalies over broad target areas.

The survey involves approximately 1,143 line-kms covering the majority the Yarmany Project area. The survey will be flown on 200m line spacings with an EM sensor altitude of 35 metres. The survey is expected to be completed within two weeks, with processing of geophysical data and interpretation to commence immediately thereafter.

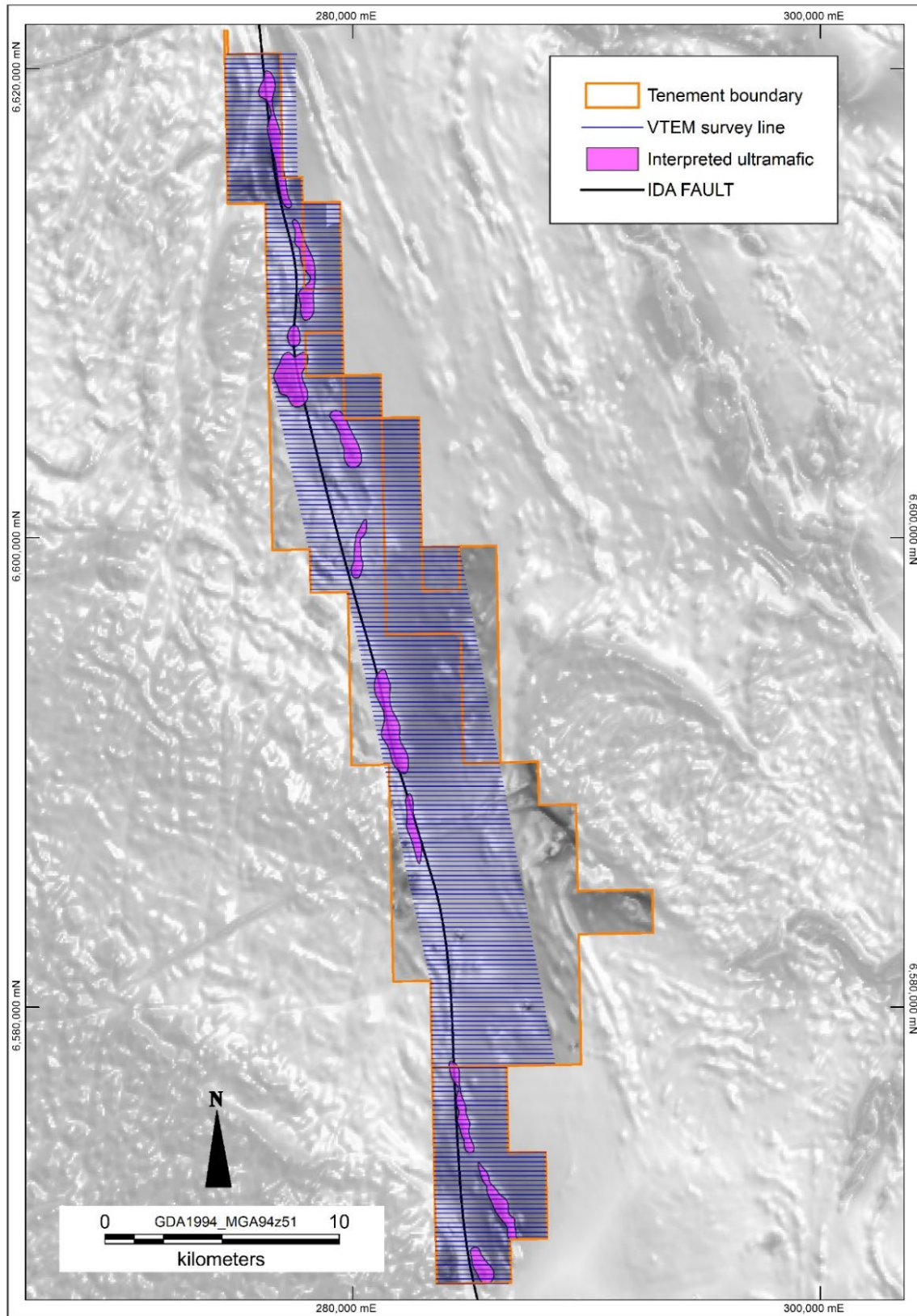


Figure 2. Yarmany Project showing planned VTEM survey lines over aeromagnetic image

In June 2023 Metal Hawk discovered high-grade clay-hosted REEs at the Fraser South Project, located 150km northeast of Esperance.

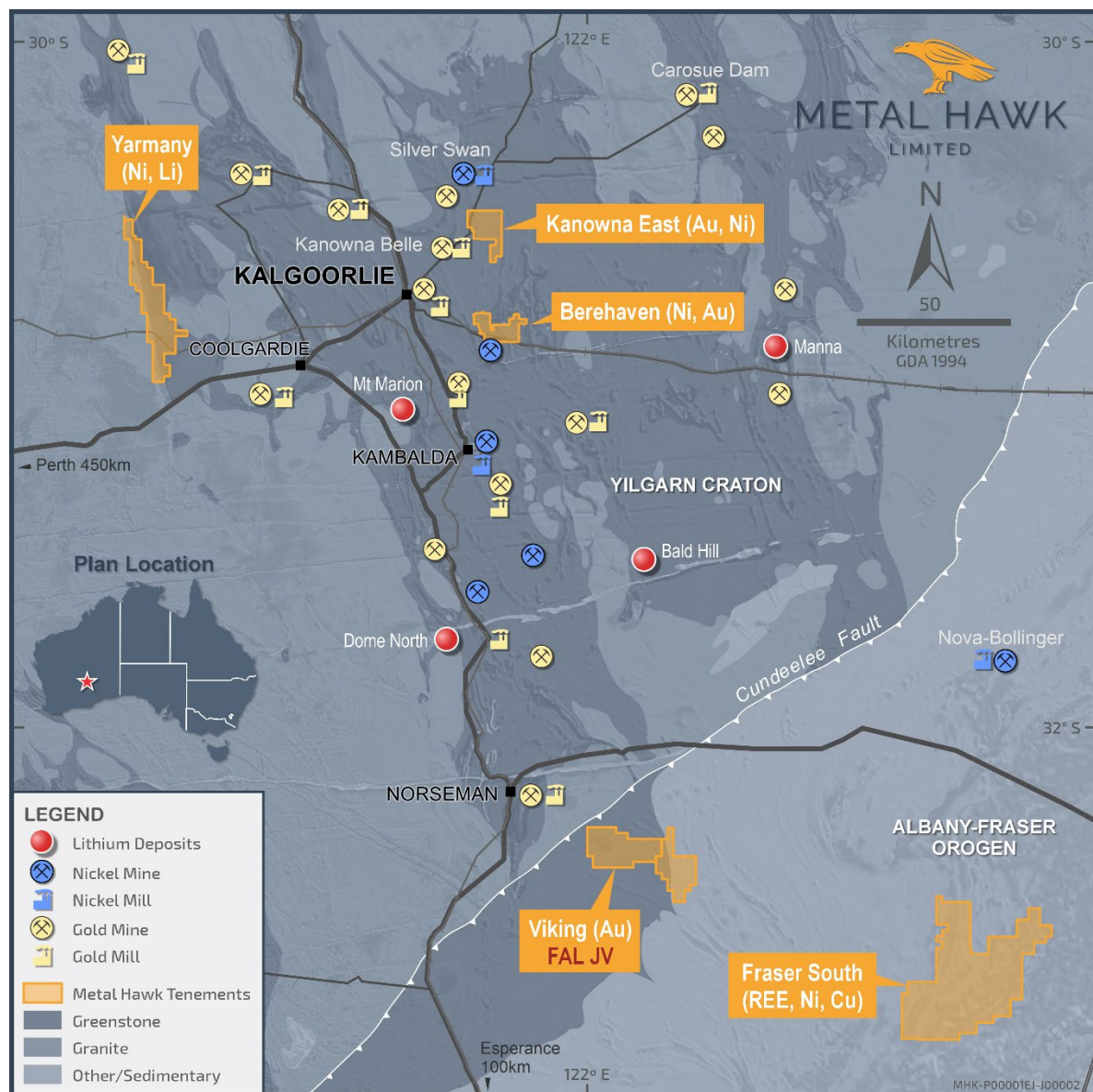


Figure 3. Metal Hawk's goldfields and Albany-Fraser project locations
