Since the closing of the share offer on 8 April 2004, Allied has been awarded new Defence Department contracts for over \$3 million worth of communications infrastructure.

In announcing the wins, Managing Director and CEO Mr Ray Doak said that the largest and most significant win was for the provision of improved services for a major Defence Department located within the Russell Offices complex in Canberra. “With Defence’s decision to build the new Headquarters Australian Theatre in the Canberra Region, the ACT remains a very important part of Allied’s market.”
