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Premier Barnett opens Perth's newest data centre

NEXTDC Limited (ASX: NXT) ("the Company" or "NEXTDC") is pleased to announce last night's opening of its newest data centre in Perth ("P1"), officially launched on Monday 24 February by the Hon. Colin Barnett MLA, Premier of Western Australia.

Attended by invited guests and VIPs representing the elite of the WA technology, investment, and government sectors, the exclusive event celebrated P1's contribution of an additional 5.5 megawatts of IT load at full fit-out – a boon for the growing cloud sector.

Premier Barnett said, "The security is quite amazing. The sophistication is equally amazing. This is a great addition to the technology and IT services growth in Western Australia."

The launch of this brand-new facility represents the completion of the company's first stage of growth (since commencing operations in 2010) and successful delivery of its initial portfolio of carrier and vendor neutral data centres.

NEXTDC CEO, Craig Scroggie said, "The launch of P1 marks a significant milestone in the life of NEXTDC. It is the night we deliver on our promise to our shareholders, the market, the ICT sector and the broader economy for a national network of independent data centres."

"From tonight, NEXTDC is operating with phase one of our vision fulfilled."

NEXTDC Chairman, Ted Pretty said, "The opening of our P1 Facility is testament to the strength and resilience of the Western Australian economy and the growing demand for high quality technology infrastructure in the State. We now have state-of-the-art facilities in the five key ICT markets in Australia."

About P1:

- P1 is Uptime Institute Tier III certified for both design and as a constructed building. P1 is Western Australia's only data centre with this distinction, and one of only eight in the entire country;
- When fully fitted out, P1 will provide 5.5 megawatts of IT load across 3,000m² of technical space and house up to 1,500 racks;
- P1 features dedicated office space on two floors available for customers to lease;
- P1 is built for energy efficiency, with an industry-leading target PUE of 1.3; and
- As a 100% independent colocation facility, P1 hosts an evolving ecosystem of carrier and IT service providers free to do business with each other.
