

Combustible Cladding Class Actions - Investment Update

Summary

- **The State of South Australia has given its consent to be a group member in the Combustible Cladding Class Actions in the Federal Court of Australia.**

Omni Bridgeway Limited (**Omni Bridgeway**) refers to its announcements of 15 February 2019 and 26 November 2020 and its Press Releases dated 18 June 2019 and 9 June 2020 regarding the two class actions commenced in the Federal Court of Australia which concern Alucobond and Vitrabond PE core cladding products (**Combustible Cladding Class Actions**).

The State of South Australia has given consent to be a group member in each of the Cladding (Alucobond) Class Action and the Cladding (Vitrabond) Class Action. By providing notice of consent, the State of South Australia joins the State of Queensland as Australian States and Territories that are group members in the Combustible Cladding Class Actions. The State of Victoria, having given a notice of consent in November 2020, has since opted out of the Combustible Cladding Class Actions.
