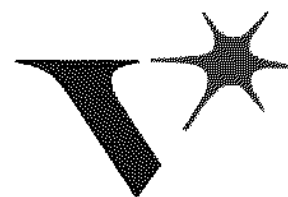

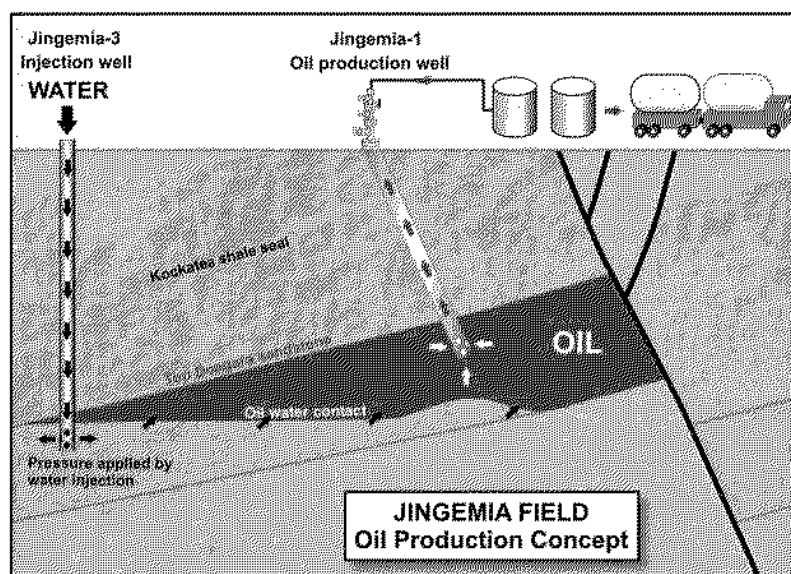

Second extended production test underway at Jingemia

Voyager Energy Limited has been advised by Origin Energy Resources Limited*, as operator of Exploration Permit 413, that a second production testing program at the Jingemia Field commenced at 1130 hours WST on 1 November following regulatory approvals and upgrades to both the access road and Jingemia temporary facilities. As at 0600 hours WST today the Jingemia 1 well was producing at approximately 1700 barrels of oil per day.

Production testing has been approved through to 1 February 2004. During the first month an interference test will be conducted between Jingemia 1 and 3. Following the results of this testing it is expected that injection of water into Jingemia 3 will provide pressure support to the reservoir. This phase of water injection is subject to separate Government approval. The aim of the extended production test is to acquire additional



information on reservoir performance and pressure maintenance to enable the formulation of a field development plan and confirm the facilities required for permanent field development.

During the period of the test the oil produced will be trucked to the BP oil refinery south of Perth for sale.
