The directors present their report on the consolidated group for the half-year ended 31 December 2025.

Principal Activities

The principal activity of the Company during the period was the exploration for minerals.

Review of Operations

The consolidated loss of the consolidated group for the financial period after providing for income tax amounted to \$195,766 (2024: \$1,255,724).

NSW Nickel Copper Gold Cobalt Projects

The Company's NSW Projects comprise the Redlands/Whitbarrow, Recovery and Lunns Dam Projects in the Tottenham-Girilambone district - four granted exploration licenses covering approx. 690km².

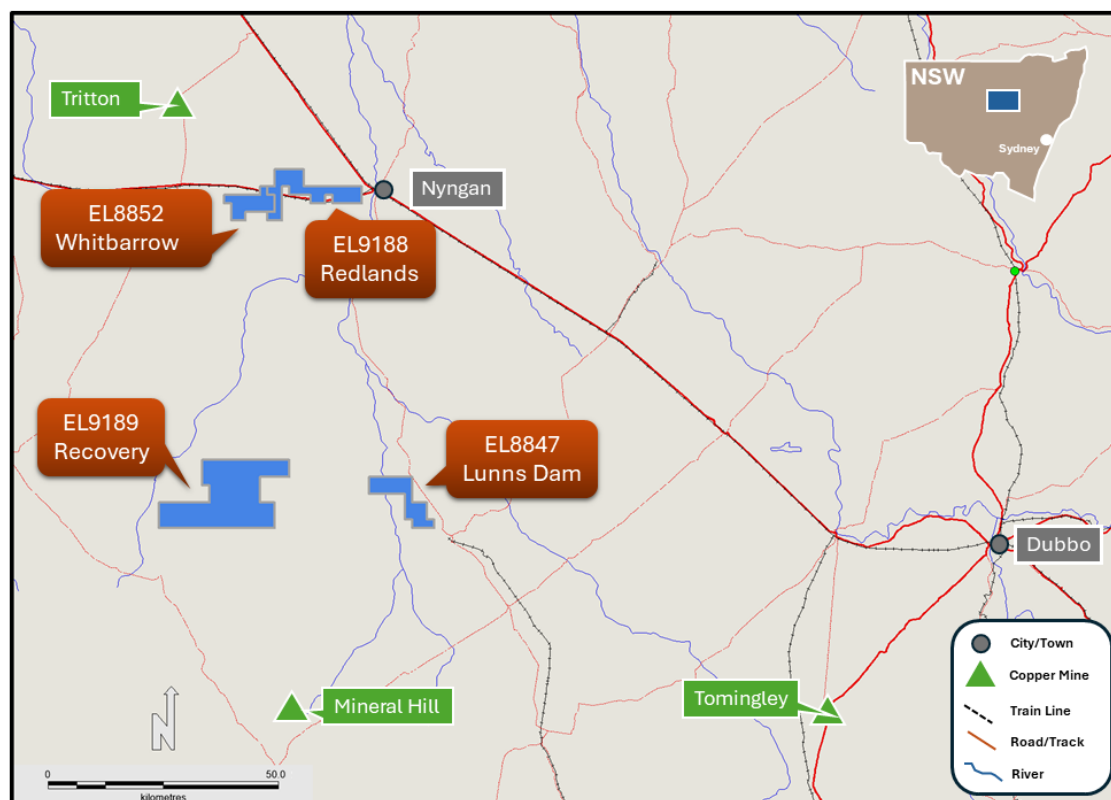


Figure 1: PBL Project Location

During the Quarter, the Company completed the Phase 3 Air Core / Reverse Circulation drilling program at the Miandetta Ni-Co prospect ('Miandetta'), part of the Redlands Project.

A total of 26 holes were completed for an aggregate of 968 metres. Depths of several Air Core drill holes were shallower than target and these holes were re-drilled with Reverse Circulation drilling.

The targeted ultramafic unit was intersected in a majority of drillholes with a variable oxide (weathering) profile that reached a maximum thickness of 43m. Phase 3 confirmed the shallow and continuous, higher-grade nickel-cobalt mineralisation was previously intersected within the oxide profile in Phase 1 and Phase 2 drilling.

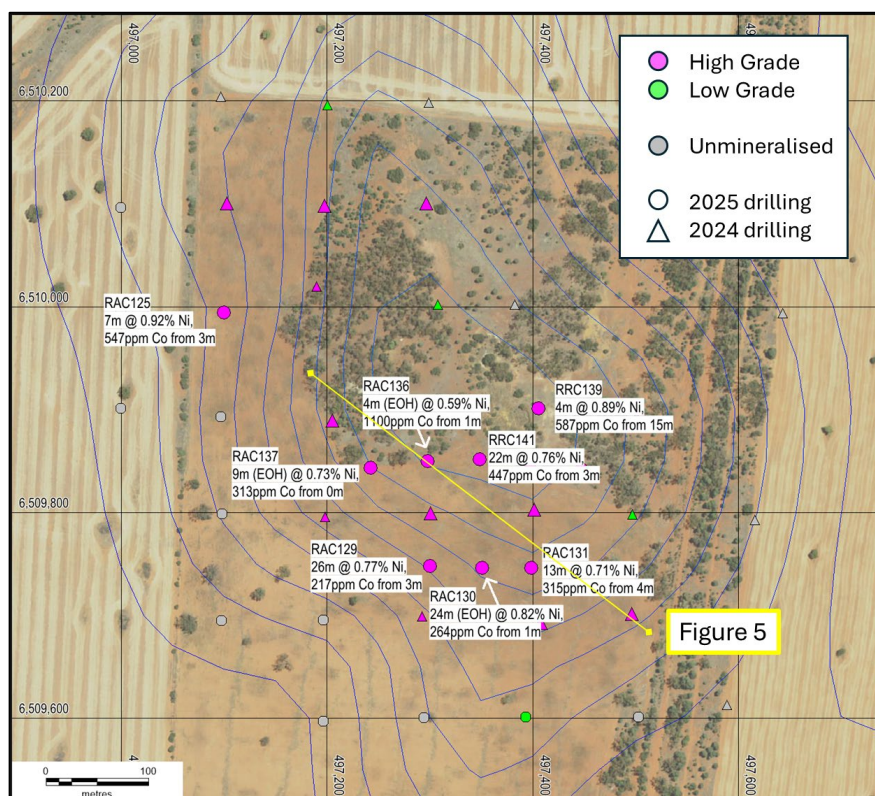


Figure 2: Miandetta Prospect – Air Core & Reverse Circulation drilling: Significant nickel results Phase 3 drilling

1. SUMMARY OF MATERIAL ACCOUNTING POLICIES

(a) Basis of preparation

The interim consolidated financial report is a general purpose financial report prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Corporations Act 2001 and Accounting Standard AASB 134: Interim Financial Reporting. Compliance with AASB 134 ensures that the financial report and notes also comply with International Financial Reporting Standards IAS 34: Interim Financial Reporting.

It is recommended that this consolidated interim financial report be read in conjunction with the annual financial report for the year ended 30 June 2025 and any public announcements made by Parabellum Resources Limited and its controlled entities (the "Group") during the half-year in accordance with the continuous disclosure requirements arising under the Corporations Act 2001 and ASX Listing Rules.

The interim consolidated financial report does not include full disclosures of the type normally included in annual financial reports.

The interim consolidated financial report has been prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historical costs, cost is based on the fair value of the consideration given in exchange for assets.

(b) Statement of compliance

The interim financial statements were authorised for issue on 6 February 2026.

The financial report complies with Australian Accounting Standards, which include Australian equivalents to International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS). During the prior period, the Company received \$324,828 in cash from Temarise Limited as a capital return which has been recognised in the profit and loss statement as a reversal of impairment.

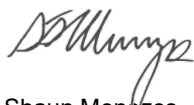

Report on the Half-Year Financial Report

Conclusion
