First Queensland Digital Imaging Sale for Pro Medicus

Pro Medicus Limited (ASX:PME) announced today that it has signed an agreement to supply its full suite of practice management and digital imaging integration products to Savage X-Ray, a new private radiology practice in central Brisbane.

Savage X-Ray will be the first fully digital private comprehensive radiology practice in Queensland when it opens its doors in June of this year. It will also serve as a local reference site for Pro Medicus as Queensland radiologists follow the worldwide trend of replacing conventional film based radiology with the far more efficient and clinically preferable digital imaging.

According to Dr Joe Savage, founder of Savage X-Ray, "Digital is a key part of our strategy for this new site. It will be far more efficient and being able to offer our referrers online access to their patients' examinations will provide us with a significant competitive advantage."

For Pro Medicus, Australia's leading supplier of digital software to the Australian private radiology market, this will be the first sale of its integration technology in Queensland and its thirteenth nationally.

According to Dr Sam Hupert, Pro Medicus CEO, "A key part of our strategy going forward is to establish reference sites for our digital technology in all states. This Brisbane deal, which is our third sale in two months, is a great step in that direction."

It subsequently announced a \$2.2 million contract with a large Canadian radiology group. Early last year, the company entered the local GP clinical desktop market with the acquisition of software technology, which is being marketed as ProMed Clinical.
