PRO-PAC PACKAGING LIMITED: INCIDENT AT KEWDALE SITE

Pro-Pac Packaging Limited's flexibles manufacturing site in Kewdale, Western Australia suffered a fire yesterday. Emergency services attended the site and successfully contained the fire to one building that housed office administration, engineering and core manufacturing. There appears to have been no material damage to the film extrusion manufacturing facilities.

The Company's site evacuation procedures were implemented immediately, and all personnel are safe with no injuries reported. The cause of the fire is not yet known.

The Company is working closely with its insurer in assessing the impact of the fire, a process which will be ongoing over the next few days. Whilst there will be short term challenges to return to full operation, the long term capability of the site does not appear to have been compromised. The Company will update the market if there is any uninsured material effect of the fire.

The Company would like to thank its local management, staff and emergency services for their prompt and professional response.
