

SECTION 708A CLEANSING NOTICE

Pursuit Minerals Ltd (ASX: **PUR**) ("**PUR**", "**Pursuit**" or the "**Company**") wishes to advise that in accordance with Shareholder approval received at the General Meeting held on 24 March 2026, the Company has issued the following:

- 26,736,843 fully paid ordinary shares ("Placement Shares") under Tranche 2 of the Placement. The Placement Shares were issued at an issue price of \$0.095 per Placement Share, raising \$2,540,000 (before costs).
- Unlisted options under the Company's Incentive Plan to Directors and officers on the terms set out in the Notice of Meeting. 5,000,000 options to Managing Director & CEO Mr Aaron Reville, 3,000,000 options to Non-Executive Chairman Mr Tom Eadie, 2,000,000 options to Non-Executive Director Mr Colin McKenzie, 2,000,000 options to Mr Vito Interlandi, and 2,000,000 options to Mr Alejandro Rodriguez.
- 14,736,842 Options issued to PAC Partners Securities Pty Ltd ("PAC Partners") who acted as Lead Manager to the Placement. The options have an exercise price of \$0.1425 and expiry date of 30 March 2028.

The Placement Shares were issued using the Company's existing placement capacity under LR7.1 and 7.1A.

Notice pursuant to Section 708A(5)(e) of the Corporations Act 2001

The Corporations Act 2001 (Cth) (Corporations Act) restricts the on-sale of securities issued without disclosure, unless the sale is exempt under section 708 or 708A of the Corporations Act. By giving this notice, the issue of the shares (together, the Shares) will fall within the exemption in section 708A(5) of the Corporations Act.

- d) as at the date of this notice, there is no information:
 - I. that has been excluded from a continuous disclosure notice in accordance with the ASX Listing Rules; and
 - II. that investors and their professional advisors would reasonably require for the purpose of making an informed assessment of:
 - i. the assets and liabilities, financial position and performance, profits and losses and prospects of the Company; or
 - ii. the rights and liabilities attaching to the Placement Shares.
