Completion of Acquisition and New Share Issue

Coventry Resources Inc. ("Coventry" or "the Company") advises that it has completed the acquisition (the "Acquisition") of Aldevco Pty Ltd ("Aldevco"), which follows the receipt of requisite shareholder approval at the Annual General and Special Meeting held on 20 February 2015.

Pursuant to the Acquisition, on 25 February 2015 Coventry issued a total of 60,000,000 new Common Shares in the capital of the Company ("the Consideration Shares") in consideration for the acquisition of 100% of the issued capital of Aldevco.

Secondary Trading Notice

The Corporations Act ("the Act") restricts the on-sale of securities issued without disclosure, unless the sale is exempt under section 708 or 708A of the Act. By the Company giving this notice, sale of the Consideration Shares, including any Chess Depositary Interests issued in respect of those shares, will fall within the exemption in section 708A(5) of the Act.

Accordingly, the Company gives notice pursuant to section 708A(5)(e) of the Act that:

- 1) the Consideration Shares were issued without disclosure to investors under Part 6D.2 of the Act;
- 2) as at the date of this notice, the Company has complied with the provisions of Chapter 2M of the Act as they apply to the Company and section 674 of the Act; and
- 3) there is no excluded information as at the date of this notice, for the purpose of sections 708A(7) and (8) of the Act.
