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RAMELIUS TIGHTENS GRIP ON

GOLD RIGHTS IN COOLGARDIE

Listed gold explorer, Ramelius Resources Limited, has acquired further gold rights to consolidate its exposure to the regional Spargoville Project near Coolgardie in Western Australia.

Ramelius announced today it will acquire the North Widgiemooltha Gold Rights from Gold Fields Australasia Pty Ltd, for \$250,000 cash.

With the acquisition, Ramelius will have gold rights to more than 30 kilometres of contiguous prospective tenements covering approximately 5,500 hectares of granted mining leases focused along the Spargos Reward and Kunanalling Shear Zones, north of the Widgiemooltha Dome.

"This region has yielded numerous gold and nickel producing mines and hosts the Company's Wattle Dam gold resource and Hilditch nickel anomaly," Ramelius' Managing Director, Mr Joe Houldsworth, said.

Base metal rights to the North Widgiemooltha block remain with Titan Resources Ltd.

Exploration licences to key blocks in the Spargoville and nearby Gnarlbine gold projects were also granted to Ramelius last week.

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
