ANDREW BASE METAL PROJECT OPTION EXERCISED EARLY

Overland Resources Limited is pleased to advise that it has elected to exercise its option to acquire 90% of the Andrew Base Metal Project in the Yukon, Canada, ahead of schedule.

Recent diamond drilling undertaken by Overland Resources has intersected mineralisation of substantial thickness, up to 30 metres. Results from recently completed drill holes and its regional exploration programmes have reinforced the Company's view that the Andrew Zinc Deposit has considerable potential to host an economic mineral deposit and significant potential exists for the surrounding area to host additional ore deposits.

To exercise its option Overland Resources Limited will immediately pay US\$250,000 and issue 5 million options, exercisable for \$0.20, to 18526 Yukon Inc., the current owner of 100% of the Andrew Base Metal Project. In exchange 18526 Yukon Inc. will transfer a 90% interest in all Quartz Mining Claims it holds within a 20km radius of the Andrew Zinc Deposit to Overland Resources Limited.

Overland Resources Limited continues the 6,000m diamond drilling programme that it commenced in June to evaluate the along strike and depth extensions of the Andrew Zinc Deposit. There is considerable potential to increase the resource with further drilling.
