

Innamincka –Yarrow 3 Well Fracking has Commenced

HIGHLIGHTS

- **Yarrow 3 Well fracking by Santos has commenced**
- **Fracking was initially delayed due to inclement weather**
- **Fracking will seek to improve gas flow and to assess well as a future producer**

Red Sky Energy (ASX:ROG) (Red Sky or the Company) is pleased to advise that the planned fracking, post the completion of the drilling of and receipt of results for the Yarrow 3 well at the Innamincka Dome licenses (**Innamincka**), commenced last Friday and should take approximately three days. Following the fracc, flow testing will be conducted which is expected to take approximately seven days. Red Sky holds 20% working interest in six PRLs (14, 17, 18, 180, 181, 182) at the Innamincka Dome in the Cooper Basin.

Santos Limited (**ASX:STO**) (**Santos**) informed Red Sky that improved conditions enabled fracking activity to begin after it was initially delayed due to severe weather conditions hampering the ability to get a rig to site. (Refer to [ASX Announcement 28 October 2022](#).)
