CHANGE OF COMPANY NAME & CAPITAL RAISING UPDATE

Taruga Minerals Limited (**Taruga** or the **Company**) (ASX:TAR) is pleased to advise that, following shareholder approval obtained on 1 June, 2018, the Company's name has officially changed with the Australian Securities and Investments Commission. There is no change to the Company's ASX ticker code of TAR.

Further to the announcement of 5 June 2018, the Company advises that it has revised the terms of the placement to raise \$2.835 million (**Placement**). The Placement will now be split into two tranches, with shares and options to be issued pursuant to the first tranche of \$1.467 million having been issued today (Tranche 1). The previously advised placement price of \$0.21 per share remains unchanged.

Pursuant to Tranche 1, Taruga issued 6,988,095 fully paid ordinary shares to professional and sophisticated investors at \$0.21 per share under the additional placement capacity from the Company's recent general meeting (GM). Additionally, 6,988,095 free attaching options were issued under the Company's ASX Listing Rule 7.1 capacity.

Tranche 2, to raise \$1 million, will be completed in mid-July and will be undertaken at the higher of:

- \$0.21 per share, or
- Subject to a \$0.26 ceiling price, a 10% discount to the 10 day VWAP prior to the date of the Tranche 2 placement.

The Board considers the restructuring of the Placement takes into account ongoing exploration activities within the DRC and limits potential dilution. Following completion of Tranche 1 of the Placement the Company has approximately \$2.75 million of cash at bank.

In addition to the issue of the securities under the Placement, the Company has also issued the various securities following the passing of the resolutions at the GM (GM Securities).
