PARTIAL CONVERSION OF SHORT TERM LOAN

Minera Gold Limited (ASX Code: MIZ) (**Minera Gold**) is pleased to advise that one of the lenders to the Company, Slade Technologies Pty Ltd has elected to convert their portion of the short term loan put in place in late March 2013 into shares following the receipt of shareholder approval at the AGM held on 27 May 2013.
