

RC DRILLING COMPLETED AT BLAIR NORTH AND VIKING

HIGHLIGHTS

- RC drilling program completed at both the Blair North Gold Project (25km east of Kalgoorlie) and the Viking Gold Project (30km east of Norseman)
- 12 holes drilled for 1,909m at Blair North, targeting high-grade gold at the Commodore, Commodore North and Snake Hill prospects
- 13 holes drilled for 1,110m at Viking, testing for extensions of gold mineralisation at the Beaker 2 and Beaker 4 prospects
- Assay results from Blair North are expected in late May 2026, with Viking results expected in early June 2026.

Talonx Resources Limited (**ASX: TXR**, “**Talonx**” or the “Company”) is pleased to advise that reverse circulation (RC) drilling programs have been completed at both the Blair North and the Viking gold projects in Western Australia. In total, 25 holes were drilled for 3,019 metres.

Dr Steve Lennon, Executive Chairman of Talonx Resources commented: *“We are very pleased to have successfully completed this campaign of drilling at Blair North and Viking. The drill rig performed efficiently and effectively across both projects and we now look forward to receiving assays, with initial results from Blair North expected in late May. There are a number of exciting gold targets that have been tested and we look forward to the upcoming results.”*

The 12-hole, 1,909m RC program at Blair North targeted quartz vein-hosted high-grade gold mineralisation along the **Commodore trend**, testing both strike and down-dip extensions to previous positive drilling results. Additional holes tested structural and geochemical gold targets at the **Snake Hill** prospect. Assay results from Blair North are expected in late May 2026.

A total of 13 holes for 1,110m were drilled at the Viking Gold Project, located 30km east of Norseman. Drilling targeted extensions of high-grade gold mineralisation at the **Beaker 2** and **Beaker 4** prospects.

At Beaker 2, drilling followed up on high-grade results from Talonx’s initial 867m RC program conducted in December 2025, which returned highlights of **5m @ 7.4g/t Au from 70m** and **14m @ 2.0g/t Au from 9m**. Assay results from the Viking program are expected in early June 2026 and will be reported to the ASX upon receipt.

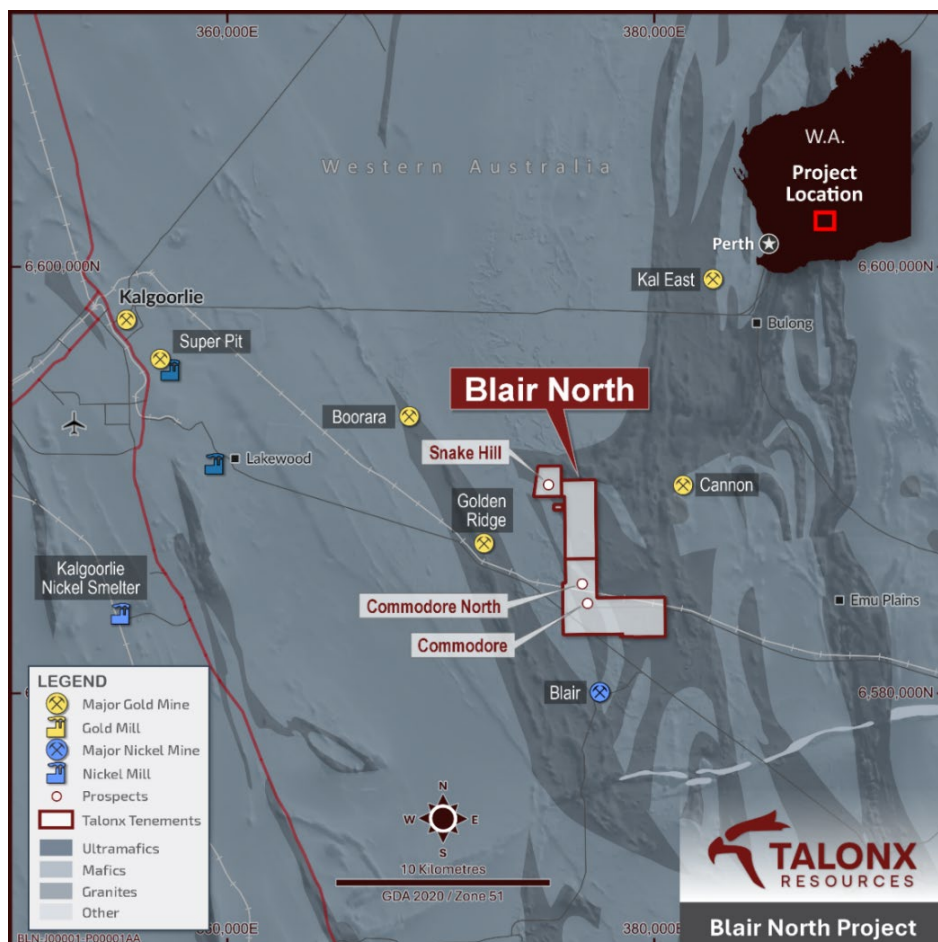


Figure 2. Blair North Project map showing key gold prospects

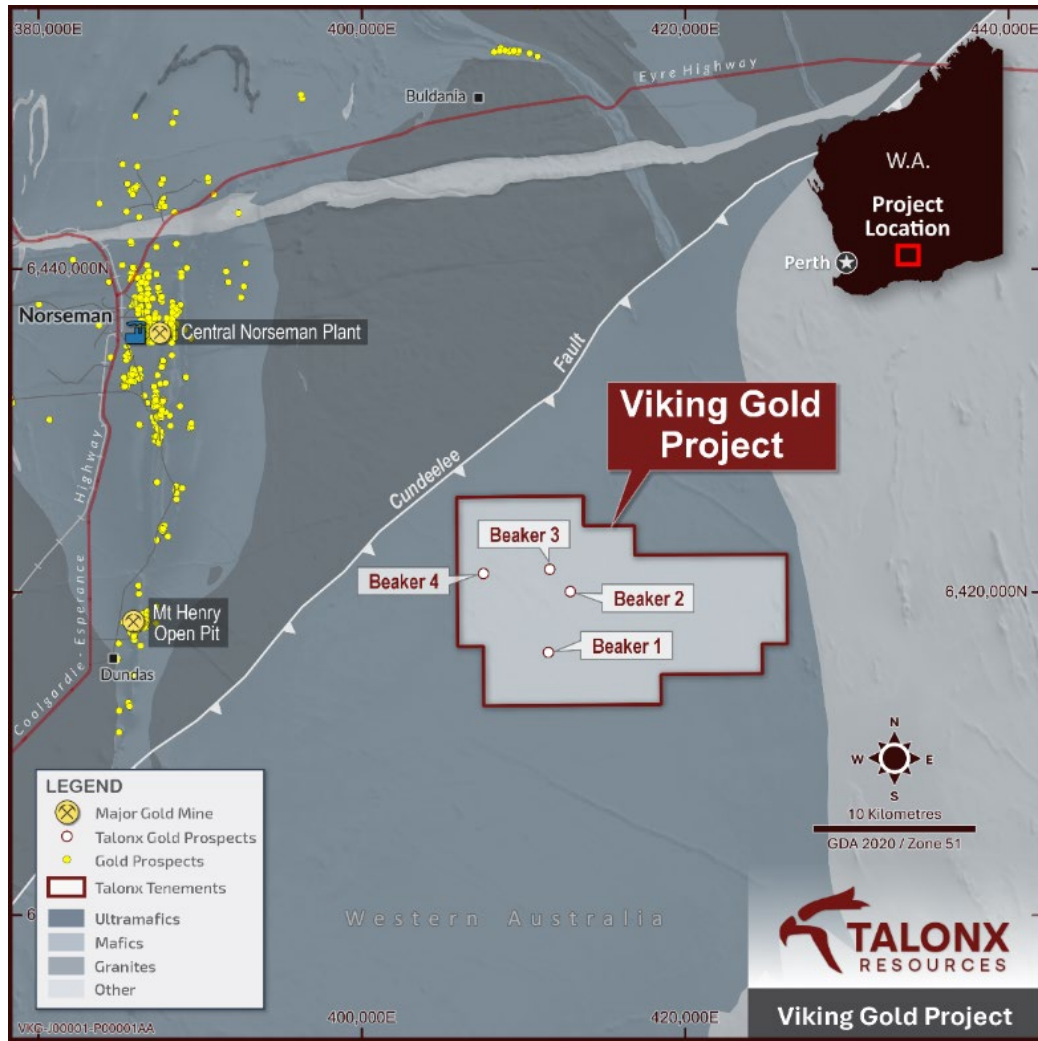


Figure 3. Viking Gold Project location
