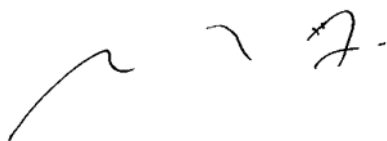
**Request for trading halt
Astute Metals NL (ASX: ASE)**

Pursuant to ASX Listing Rule 17.1, Astute Metals NL (ASX: **ASE**) (**the Company**) requests that a trading halt (**Trading Halt**) be applied to its ordinary shares, effective immediately (3 April 2024).

In accordance with ASX Listing Rule 17.1, the Company provides the following information:

- (a) the Trading Halt has been requested pending an announcement regarding the results from the Scoping Study of the Governor Broome Project (**Purpose**);
- (b) the Company requests that the Trading Halt continue to apply until the earlier of:
 - i. such time as the Company releases an announcement to ASX in relation to the Purpose; or
 - ii. the commencement of trading on Thursday, 4 April 2024; and
- (c) the Company is not aware of any reason why the trading halt should not be granted, nor is it aware of any other information available at this stage that is necessary to inform the market about the Trading Halt.
