**WIDE OPEN AGRICULTURE RECEIVES R&D REBATE RELATING TO  
OVERSEAS ACTIVITIES**

Wide Open Agriculture Ltd (ASX:WOA) (“WOA or “the Company”) is pleased to announce that it has received a tax rebate, including interest, of \$586,624 relating to overseas research and development (“R&D”) activities within its German production facility for the 2023-24 financial year.

The refund is part of the Australian Government’s R&D tax incentive scheme administered by the Australian Taxation Office and AusIndustry, under which companies can receive up to 43.5% refundable tax offset of eligible expenses.

During 2025 Wide Open Agriculture received a favourable Overseas Finding, confirming that the R&D work being undertaken outside Australia was critical to developing WOA’s proprietary lupin protein isolates manufacturing process, and was therefore eligible for inclusion in the R&D tax incentive claim.

The tax rebate of \$586k including interest, will be used to support operational expenses related to the commercialisation of its novel lupin protein and oil products.
