Issue of Shares

Xref Limited (ASX:XF1) (Xref or the Company) advises that it has issued a total of 2,674,632* new fully paid ordinary shares. The shares have been issued at a 7-day volume-weighted average price of \$0.18 per share.

The shares have been issued for the following reasons:

1. 1,354,483 shares were allotted to 56 of Xref's staff, senior management and executives who agreed to work a four-day week from 1 April 2020 until 30 June 2020. All forgone salaries as a result of the 20% pay cut have been replaced with fully paid ordinary shares.
2. The commission scheme paid to sales staff changed on 1 July 2020. All cash commissions due for credits that remain unused by clients, and bonuses due, have instead been paid in fully paid ordinary shares. Accordingly, a total of 1,320,149 fully paid ordinary shares have been allotted to members of the Xref sales team.
3. The Executive and Non-Executive Directors also agreed to take a 20% reduction in their salaries and fees, respectively, for the three months to 30 June 2020, and it will be proposed to shareholders (for approval at the 2020 Annual General Meeting) that they too be paid in shares to make up for the cash forgone.
