Launch of “Air Taxi Egypt” Service in Egypt

Cairo—Saturday, October 11, 2025

Cairo witnessed an exceptional event in the field of transport and aviation, with the official launch of the “Air Taxi Egypt” service, the first project of its kind in Egypt to provide air taxi services. The launch took place during a grand ceremony held in front of the Pyramids of Giza, attended by a number of ministers, high-ranking officials, ambassadors, business leaders, and media representatives.

The project is the result of a strategic partnership with Abu Dhabi Aviation, one of the largest helicopter operators in the Middle East, with more than 49 years of experience. The company contributes its operational, training, and fleet management expertise in a collaboration that reflects the integration between national capabilities and regional experience in advanced civil aviation.

TCM Economic Consulting, the advisory arm of the Prime Egypt Group, is also participating in the project in cooperation with Abu Dhabi Aviation. TCM plays a key role in commercial operations management, feasibility studies, marketing, and expansion plans inside and outside Egypt, enhancing the integration of local and regional expertise in developing modern air transport solutions.

The event also included presentations detailing the project’s features, operational plans, and expansion strategy, followed by a demonstration flight over the Giza Pyramids and the Grand Egyptian Museum, amid extensive media coverage highlighting the project’s significance and its role in supporting and developing Egypt’s aviation sector.

The Air Taxi Egypt service aims to bring about a qualitative leap in the concept of travel within Egypt through short and fast air trips connecting cities and tourist destinations in just minutes, using a fleet of modern helicopters operated under the highest international standards of safety and quality.

The first phase of operations will begin from Almaza Airport in Cairo, covering destinations such as the New Administrative Capital, Sheikh Zayed, the North Coast, El Gouna, Siwa, the New Valley, Sharm El-Sheikh, Hurghada, Luxor, and Aswan. This service is expected to open new horizons for luxury tourism, corporate and official transportation, as well as medical and emergency flights.

The service is offered in two main categories, Comfort Class and VIP Class, targeting various client segments including domestic and international tourists through short flights over the Pyramids, the Nile, and archaeological sites; governmental and official delegations through customized services equipped with secured communications and optional security escort; and corporations and

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business executives through monthly and annual operation contracts that include ground transport, luxury lounges, and executive assistance.

The ceremony featured speeches by several representatives of the participating entities, including His Excellency Hamad Obaid Al Zaabi, Ambassador of the United Arab Emirates to the Arab Republic of Egypt; Mr. Mahmoud Al Hay Al Hameli, Chief Executive Officer of Abu Dhabi Aviation Group; and Engineer Tamer Wagih, Chairman of Prime Egypt Group and TCM Consulting.

His Excellency Ambassador Hamad Al Zaabi expressed his pride in participating in this event, which reflects the deep and solid brotherly relations between the United Arab Emirates and the Arab Republic of Egypt, affirming that the project represents a model of joint cooperation in the fields of development and modernization, and enhances Egypt's position as a leading destination for tourism and business.

For his part, Mr. Mahmoud Al Hameli, CEO of Abu Dhabi Aviation Group, confirmed that launching the Air Taxi project in Egypt represents a qualitative step toward the development of smart air transport, adding that Abu Dhabi Aviation continues its over five-decade-long journey in supporting the aviation sector and providing advanced transport solutions that contribute to regional development and integration.

Engineer Tamer Wagih stated that the Air Taxi Egypt project marks the beginning of a new phase in the smart transportation and luxury tourism system in Egypt, reflecting the country's orientation toward sustainable and advanced technology solutions. He added that the partnership between the three parties brings together operational and commercial expertise to deliver an air transport experience meeting global standards.

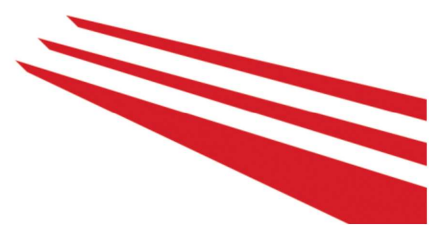
The project represents a significant addition to Egyptian tourism, particularly with the continuous growth in the number of Arab and international visitors. Feasibility studies indicate that Egypt receives more than eleven million international tourists annually, including nearly two million Gulf tourists, creating a promising market for luxury and specialized air transport services. It is also expected that the project will contribute to enhancing the attractiveness of new cities, such as the New Administrative Capital and New Alamein City, and facilitate the access of investors and business leaders to these destinations.

Air Taxi Egypt plans to gradually expand its services to include tourist attractions in the Red Sea, Sinai, and the oases, along with the launch of a digital booking application and the development of joint travel packages in collaboration with major hotels and tourist resorts.
