## Immediate Report - Publication of a Call for Public Comments by the Ministry of Communications Regarding a Re-examination of the Structural Separation Obligation Imposed on the Bezeq and HOT Groups

Further to the provisions of Section 1.7.3 of the chapter describing the corporation's business in the Company's 2024 periodic report, and the update to that section in the Company's quarterly report for the period ending June 30, 2025, regarding the structural separation imposed on the Company, an immediate report is hereby given that on October 22, 2025, the Ministry of Communications published a call for public comments to the public and telecommunications companies regarding a re-examination of the structural separation obligation imposed on the Bezeq and HOT groups.

According to the call for comments, the Ministry of Communications is seeking public input regarding a thorough and comprehensive examination of the structural separation obligation on the Bezeq and HOT telecommunications groups, in light of the changes in the fixed-line communications market in Israel, characterized by an accelerated transition from copper infrastructure to advanced fiber optic networks and the entry of new players into the infrastructure and other markets. The call for comments also notes that it is unclear whether the current separation fulfills its intended purpose and that, from a competitive perspective, the existing model may only partially address competitive concerns. Therefore, there is a need to examine whether it is preferable to move to other models that would result in a better market structure. Accordingly, the call for comments focuses on three main policy alternatives (although other alternatives may also be raised):

- Alternative A Complete cancellation of the structural separation
- Alternative B Functional separation
- Alternative C Separation of ownership of the passive infrastructure

As stated in previous reports by the Company, in the Company's assessment, if the structural separation is completely canceled, this is expected to have a materially positive impact on the Company's results. The Company is studying the call for comments and examining the implications of the other alternatives and intends to submit its response to the Ministry by the set deadline of November 11, 2025.
