

## Elbit Systems to Supply the Polish Ministry of National Defense with Multi-Sensor Monitoring and Surveillance Systems

The systems will be provided by a consortium led by Elbit Systems and the Polish Military Communication Institute

Haifa, Israel, December 20, 2010 – Elbit Systems Ltd. (NASDAQ and TASE: ESLT) ("ESLT") announced today that it was awarded a contract valued at approximately \$16 million from the Polish Ministry of National Defense to supply mobile multi-sensor monitoring and surveillance systems for the Polish Army. The project is scheduled to be completed in the next year.

According to the contract, a consortium composed of Elbit Systems Land and C<sup>4</sup>I-Tadiran and the Polish Military Communication Institute, will provide a variety of sensors to be deployed onboard a ROSOMAK 8X8 vehicle. The systems onboard the vehicle will be comprised of a variety of visual payloads, TV, thermal vision systems, motion detection battlefield surveillance radar unit, encrypted communications systems, as well as an unmanned aircraft system (UAS) system. The project will be performed in cooperation with the local Polish industries.
