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UPDATE IN RELATION TO INVESTIGATION ON FIRE INCIDENT

The Board of Directors ("**Board**") of H2G Green Limited (the "**Company**", together with its subsidiaries, collectively the "**Group**") refers to the Company's announcements dated 28 July 2025, 9 October 2025, 21 October 2025, 2 December 2025 and 30 December 2025, in respect of a fire incident that occurred on the evening of 27 July 2025 at the operating site of its subsidiary, Green Energy Investment Holding Private Limited ("**GEIH**"), in Jurong.

The Company wishes to inform that the representatives of GEIH and the legal counsel for GEIH, had on 20 January 2026, attended the mention at the State Courts as scheduled. At the mention, GEIH's legal counsel had requested, and was granted by the Court, (i) the adjournment of the mention for another 3 weeks to 10 February 2026, and (ii) a roundtable discussion to take place before the next mention between GEIH, the Singapore Civil Defence Force ("**SCDF**"), and other relevant government authorities (such as The National Environment Agency ("**NEA**") to discuss the charge under Section 61(1) of the Fire Safety Act 1993.

The Company will make necessary announcements to keep shareholders updated as and when there are material developments.

Shareholders and potential investors are advised to exercise caution when dealing in the shares of the Company. Persons who are in doubt as to the action they should take should consult their stockbrokers, bank managers, solicitors, accountants or other professional advisers.
