CYPARK PARTICIPATES IN DOCUMENT EXCHANGE CEREMONY AT ETCON26 FOR A RM1.962 BILLION EPCC CONTRACT FOR THE KENYIR HYDRO HYBRID FLOATING SOLAR PROJECT



Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia [3 JUNE 2026] – Cypark Resources Berhad (“Cypark” or “the Group”), a leading renewable energy and environmental solutions provider, today announced that a document exchange ceremony was held at the Energy Transition Conference 2026 (“ETCON26”) in relation to the RM1.962 billion Engineering, Procurement, Construction and Commissioning Contract (“EPCC Contract”) between a consortium consist of Cypark Renewable Energy Sdn Bhd and Fabulous Sunview Sdn Bhd (“Contractor”) and TI TNB GENCO Solar Kenyir 1 Sdn. Bhd. (“TI TNB GENCO”) for the development of the 595MWac Hydro Hybrid Floating Solar (“HHFS”) photovoltaic plant integrated with battery energy storage system (“BESS”) at Kenyir Lake, Terengganu (“Kenyir HHFS Project”).

The document exchange ceremony was witnessed by the Deputy Prime Minister of Malaysia and Minister of Energy Transition and Water Transformation (PETRA), YAB Datuk Amar Haji Fadillah bin Haji Yusof. TI TNB GENCO is the special purpose vehicle established by TNB Power Generation Sdn. Bhd. (“TNB GENCO”) and Terengganu Inc Sdn. Bhd. (“Terengganu Inc”) to undertake the development of the Kenyir HHFS Project.

The EPCC Contract, valued at RM1.962 billion, follows the Letter of Acceptance announced on 3 April 2026 and marks the formal transition of the Kenyir HHFS Project from award stage into execution. The Kenyir HHFS Project is expected to be completed in 2028 and upon completion, the Kenyir HHFS Project is set to become the largest floating solar photovoltaic development in Southeast Asia, marking a major milestone for the region and reinforcing Malaysia’s leadership in large-scale clean energy infrastructure. As one of Malaysia’s major renewable energy infrastructure

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developments, the Kenyir HHFS Project carries strategic significance for the country's energy transition. Beyond its scale, the project will support Malaysia's energy security, advance clean energy deployment and demonstrate the potential of floating solar integrated with BESS to strengthen the resilience and sustainability of the national power system.

The signing of the EPCC Contract for the Kenyir HHFS Project represents an important execution milestone for Cypark, reinforcing the Group's ability to convert secured opportunities into deliverable infrastructure projects. The EPCC Contract further strengthens Cypark's position as a renewable energy platform with capabilities across project development, engineering, construction, commissioning and long-term asset operations. It also provides greater visibility over Cypark's near-to-medium term earnings, supported by the Group's EPCC capabilities and experience in delivering complex renewable energy projects.
